THE RULES GOVERNING THE COMPETITION

1. The essay should be written only in English and be NO MORE than 1500 words long, excluding references.
2. The competition is open only for the students of BVDU New Law College, Pune.
3. It should be word-processed preferably using Microsoft Word, using double line spacing, with each page numbered, and with the essay title on the top of each page. The essay should NOT be printed double-sided, so there should be typing on just one side of each page.
4. Do not include any pictures or other illustrations.
5. The participant's name and the name of the class should NOT be on the essay cover page or anywhere in the essay. This means that the essays can be judged anonymously. Of course, the Participant's name and the name of the school should be provided on the corresponding email and the registration form.
6. References - books, articles or online sources that are cited should be listed at the end of the essay.
7. The essay should be an original piece of work. It should be written in the Participant's own words and not copied from any books, articles, or from the internet.
8. The entries must be sent by filling up the *Entry/ Registration Form*. The Registration form is available at- www.bvplcpune.org

10. The Last date for registration is 20th January, 2018.
11. The last date to receive the entries for evaluation is 27th January, 2018.
12. The first prize shall be comprised of 5,000/- INR, the second prize 3,000/- INR and the third Prize 1,000/- INR.
