### Induction Day IV: "Awareness & Career in Cyber Law"


### **REPORT**

























# Report on Workshop


We had various eminent speakers from different walks of the Legal Fraternity imparting knowledge and training our students to face the challenges of tomorrow.

The participants were from Bharati Vidyapeeth (Deemed to be University) New Law College and Bharati Vidyapeeth Institute of Management Research, New Delhi.


