She turns over the leaves dreamily; finds her page; turns the book inside out at it; and, with a happy sigh, gets into bed and prepare to read herself to sleep. But before abandoning herself to fiction, she raises her eyes once more, thinking of the blessed reality, and murmurs) My hero! my hero!

A distant shot breaks the quiet of the night. She starts, listening; and two more shots, much nearer, follow, startling her so that she scrambles out of bed, and hastily blows out the candle on the chest of drawers. then, putting her fingers in her ears, she runs to the dressing table, blows out the light there, and hurries back to bed in the dark, nothing being visible but the glimmer of the light in the pierced ball before the image, and the starlight seen through the slits at the top of the shutters. The firing breaks out again: there is a startling fusillade quite close at hand. Whilst it is still echoing, the shutters disappear, pulled open from without; and for an instant the rectangle of snowy starlight flashes out with the figure of a man silhouetted in black upon it. The shutters close immediately; and the room is dark again. But the silence is now broken by the sound of panting. Then there is a scratch and the flame of a match is seen in the middle of the room.

The issuing of a writ of Mandamus is absolutely discretionary with a court and cannot be demanded as a matter of right. According to Halsbury, "The grant of a writ of Mandamus is, as a general rule, a matter for the discretion of the Court. It is not writ of right and it is not issued as a matter of course". Accordingly, the court may grant the writ even though the right in respect of which it is applied for appears to be doubtful, and on the other hand, the writ may be refused, not only upon the merits, but also by reason of the special circumstances of the case. The court will take a liberal view in determining whether or not the writ shall be issued, nor scrupulously weighing the degree of public importance attained by the matter which may be in question, but applying this remedy in all cases where, upon a reasonable construction, it can be shown to be relevant. Thus the writ has been held to lie for surrender of a regalia of a corporation to oblige corporate bodies to affix their common seal, to compel a corporation to pay a sum of money pursuant to an agreement which could not be enforced by action, and to command a mayor and corporation to exercise the ancient privilege of holding a court for determining suits notwithstanding long disuse.
