4. **Implementing Specific Activities**


Supplemental Agreements will be entered into to establish details for the operation and implementation of specific activities under the MoU and will become annexures to this Agreement.

5. **Copyright and Intellectual Property Rights**

Any intellectual Property Right generated in the course of a joint project will be jointly owned and equally shared between both institutions, unless otherwise specifically spelt out in the relevant joint project document.

6. **Applicable Law**

This Agreement shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of Uganda and Republic of India depending on where the subject matter warranting interpretation is located.

7. Dispute Resolution

Any dispute related to this Agreement shall be settled by negotiations between the two institutions. In case this is not successful, the dispute shall be resolved through an arbitrator appointed by the two parties by mutual agreement. Should the parties fail to reach such agreement within one month of a request for arbitration by any party, the arbitrator shall be appointed by a judge of the Supreme Court sitting at Chambers. The ruling of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both parties.

8. Terms and Termination


This memorandum shall be effective from the date of signing and shall remain in effect for a period of five (5) years renewable by mutual consent of the parties.

In so far as they do not interfere with any activities in progress, amendments to this agreement may be made at any time, provided they are in writing and reflect the joint wish of both Parties to this Agreement.

In so far as the termination does not interfere with any activities in progress, either party may terminate this agreement by giving three (3) months written notice.




