Scope:

Aims of the Research Policy:

BVDU New Law College aims to create and support a research culture for developing and promoting Legal research abilities among its teachers, staff and students. It also aims at ensuring that the research activities of the New Law College conform to all applicable rules and regulation as well as to the established standards and norms relating to ethical conduct of research.

Objectives of the Research Policy:

- To ensure the quality of all research activities of the New Law College and to monitor, examine, promote the highest standards of

ethics and integrity in the conducting research by all types of researchers i.e. teachers, Students, Phd Scholars, Principal Investigator, etc.

- To identify and inform researchers about the appropriate research opportunities announced by different Funding agencies, academic institutions, research industry or government organizations, etc.
- To create an awareness about Copyright Protection and Intellectual Property Rights and motivate them to apply for IPR Protection.
- To identify and establish linkages, associations, collaborations including MOUs for long term relationships with national and international research organizations for widening the scope of research opportunities and funding options available to the teachers and students of the college.
- To encourage and facilitate the publication of the research works in reputed academic International / National journals and also to facilitate the presentation of the research work through academic events such as workshops/seminars/conferences/Conference Proceedings.
- To encourage faculty members to publish research papers and undertake various research projects.
- To publish a research journal, to provide a platform to the faculty members, as well as researchers and academicians in the college as well as in those from academia across the country.
- To ensure the quality of all research activities of the college and to observe the highest standards of ethics and integrity in the conduct of their research, all researchers must follow the following Code of ethics.

Responsibilities:

- **Encourage and promote a research culture :** Legal Research Centre has to organize awareness programmes, guest lectures, faculty development programs, Conference proceedings, conference, workshops, seminars, training programmes on research and development in the institute.
- Legal Research Centre has to promote, introduce and revise curriculum on research development programs and for students at UG and PG Courses.
- To conduct Non doctrinal research work and survey with the help of faculty and students for betterment of society.
- To guide and assist prospective research development programs on various aspects such as preparing project reports, obtaining projects and other facilities from funding agencies. Prepare budgets for supporting students' and faculties research projects.
- To act as an information centre on research opportunities, procedure for application, provide and share details about call for papers/ projects etc. among students and faculties.
- create and maintain research database of faculties / students of New Law College,Pune
- To conduct research development training program leading to self employment
- Offering support and Guidance to researchers for executing their research.
