The goldsmith took with him some ornaments entrusted to his care by customers, so as to enable his wife to wear the ornaments at the marriage. On the way a gang of robbers attacked them and took away all their goods along with the ornaments. Can the customers make the goldsmith liable for the loss of their ornaments?
