Othello, Macbeth, Hamlet and King Lear are known as the Four Great Tragedies of Shakespeare. Their greatest quality is that they are tragedies because their heroes have a fatal flaw. Othello had an inferiority complex due to his dark complexion; Macbeth was over-ambitious; Hamlet was indecisive; and King Lear was proud. These flaws result in tragic consequences. Centuries earlier, Aristotle had defined this idea of a fatal flaw as 'Hamartia'. However, before Shakespeare, most tragedies focussed on an ideal hero who was dragged into tragic circumstances by an evil villain. Shakespeare dived into the psychologies of his heroes, made them their own enemy and gave a new dimension to the idea of 'tragedy'.

Metaphors like 'heads will roll' and 'have someone's head on a platter' are examples from the English language, which signify the divestment of power and authority through the removal of the head from the body.

In tribal societies, the symbolism associated with the head is extended to animal heads too and this has both a profane and a sacred significance. For example, in Naga villages when animals are slaughtered for community feasts, the head of the biggest animal is always given to the chief or the headman as a token to recognition of his status in the community. The Ao tribe still follows a traditional custom of sending back the head of a big animal like a pig to the person who sent it as a gift in acknowledgment of his ownership of the animal. In another Naga tribe called Sangtam, the heads of chickens or even fish heads cannot be eaten by anyone else except the head of the family, i.e. the father.
