However, if we don't understand and solve the larger underlying causes of the crime, we are not reforming the society.

The problem of procrastination – of delaying things unnecessarily - has several underlying causes. The first and most commonly cited cause is laziness – that people postpone actions merely because they're lazy. However, this explanation itself is lazy, as it does not try to analyse complicated reasons. The second and more psychological reason for procrastination is anxiety. People often fear the consequences of one's actions and try to avoid any unpleasant effects. Anxious people also have the problem of perfection, i.e., they want to do things exactly as they've imagined them. Such 'perfect' conditions are rarely present in real life and this leads to procrastination. The solution to this problem is to understand that doing something is better than doing nothing. The third and more material reason for procrastination is poor time management. It is understandable that we are often burdened with too many tasks and we get overwhelmed in the process. The solution in this case is to prioritise, to understand which task is more important and dedicate time accordingly. Like for any problem, procrastination needs to be analysed. The solutions lie in the reasons. (184 words)
