- Q.3 Critically evaluate the Abstraction, Filtration and Comparison (AFC) test laid down by US Courts in the case of *Computer Associates* v. *Altai*. Also explain relevant provisions of copyright infringement in computer programs.
- Q.4 Sudhir is a journalist. He reports and writes out news items on the weather section. Determine who has a copyright in the news that he reports and who has copyright in the news items that he writes down. Describe relevant copyright provisions.
- Q.5 Critically evaluate TRIPS provisions relating to pharmaceutical patents with the help of leading case laws.
- Q.6 Write an elaborate note on evolution of different intellectual properties and measures for their protection with the help of international conventions.
