# Two - Days International Seminar On

"Recent Trends in Juvenile Justice System: Revisiting Basic Concepts and Public Perceptions"

(28-29<sup>th</sup> September 2018)

International Seminar being organized on "Recent Trends in Juvenile Justice System: Revisiting Basic Concepts and Public Perceptions" on 28-29th September, 2018. The Seminar is funded by the Indian Council of Social Science Research, Mumbai (Western Regional Centre).

The aim of the Seminar is to bring together academicians, Social scientists, Researchers, Policy makers and Community stake holders to exchange and share their experiences and research results on all aspects of Juvenile Justice. Selected papers will be published in the Special Issue of Bharati Law Review.

## **Publication of Papers**

The papers selected for the aforesaid theme of the International Seminar shall be published in a special edition of Bharati Law Review ISSN 2278-6996, which is a quarterly double blind peer reviewed, UGC approved journal. We look forward to submissions from members of the Bar, Bench and the academia. Submissions can only be in the form of Long Articles.

## **Nature of Contributions**

**Articles**: An article must conduct a complete analysis of the area of law, which the author seeks to highlight. It must contain a comprehensive study of the existing law, indicating the lacunae therein, and must contain an attempt to suggest possible changes which can address the said lacunae. An article should be between 4,000-5,000 words.

#### **Submission Guidelines**

- 1. Word Limit: As has already been indicated, the maximum word limit for articles and essays is 5,000 words (exclusive of footnotes) whereas that for notes and comments is 2,500 words (exclusive of footnotes).
- 2. Citation Format: The citation format to be used is The Bluebook (19th ed.). In keeping with the same, speaking footnotes are discouraged.
- 3. Abstract: Every submission should be accompanied by an abstract of not more than 350 words describing the relevant conclusions drawn in the manuscript. Please note that there is no requirement of prior submission of abstract as the selection of the paper for publication shall be on the full manuscript. The abstract shall serve merely to help the Editorial Board in its review process.
- 4. Biographical Information of Authors: A document with biographical information of the authors must be given in the footnote of Author's Name including the following details: Post, Email address, Postal Address, Name and Address of Institution, Course (if applicable), Academic Year.

### **Submission Deadline**

The last date for submission of **Abstract** is **August 15, 2018.** 

The last date for submission of Full Article if August 31, 2018.

#### **Mode of Submission**

-Submissions of **Abstract** shall be made on or before **August 15, 2018** by sending an e-mail at blr@bvpnlcpune.org.

In addition to the Abstract, each submission should contain a separate file containing the following information:

- -The topic of the Article
- -The Author's name and affiliation
- -A short (one-page) CV of the author
- -Contact details including e-mail address and phone number

Information regarding Selection of Abstracts shall be communicated to the author by August 20, 2018.

-Submission of full article shall be made on or before **August 31, 2018** by sending an e-mail at **blr@bvpnlcpune.org**.

Submissions should be made along with Plagiarism Test Report and complete details of Author(s).
